Guest Speaker PJ Blodgett Pack 107

PJ Blodgett presented a re-charter for Pack 107. PJ gave updates about the Pack, including new members and new committee chairs within the Pack as PJ will be finishing up his last year. There are currently 87 members in the Troop. A motion was made to re-charter the Pack. It was seconded and approved.

Guest Speaker Bruce Wallace Troop 107

Troop 107 has had great success in graduating scouts through the Troop. Many Eagle Scout projects are completed here at Bunker Hill. A motion was made to re-charter the Troop. It was seconded and approved.

Guest Speaker Todd Livesay, FTCSC Transportation

Todd Livesay gave a presentation on the Transportation department in the township. Over 9000 students ride the busses each day, traveling more than 5000 miles. The presentation included bus regulations, important information, safety. All new busses coming to the district will have seat belts as well as cameras on the stop arms. The stop arm camera is automated to take a photo of cars that ignore the stop sign to pass a stopped bus and a ticket will be issued to the driver. A new program called Stopfinder is coming to the township. The first phase will be in place by the end of the semester. By the end of the school year, the second phase will be in place. Stopfinder will enable parents to login and see real-time updates of their child's bus as well as receive push notifications in case of late busses, etc.
